# *Praying for God's Mission in Hong Kong*



## **MCN Mission Partners**

Mission Partners serve in churches and schools of the Lutheran Church–Hong Kong Synod and at Hong Kong International School, reaching out to students, families, and coworkers with the hope of the Gospel.

### **Day 1 – Open Ears**

Hong Kong is a highly secularized city with strong ties to Chinese traditional folk religion. Pray for everyone to hear the Gospel and know what Jesus has done for them.

### **Day 2 – The Lutheran Church–Hong Kong Synod**

The Lutheran Church–Hong Kong Synod has a large network of churches, schools, service centers, and care facilities. Pray for God to continue to grow the current Christian ministries in Hong Kong, and that all these churches and ministries may together show God's love to members of the community of all ages and backgrounds.

## **Day 3 – God of All Nations**

Christianity is often only associated with western foreigners. Pray that Hong Kongers would know that the Glory of the Lord is not a foreigner but the God of every nation who desires a restored relationship with everyone in the world.

## **Day 4 – Hong Kong Families**

Hong Kong culture places high value on family. Pray for good relationships and peace within Hong Kong families, and for people to accept that there is a Heavenly Father who loves them unconditionally and wants them in His family.

## **Day 5 – Expatriates**

Hong Kong is a highly international city with a large number of expatriates (foreigners from other countries). Pray for God to help all of his children feel connected to His global Church, and for a joint identity in Christ regardless of our home culture or where we are in the world.
